A Message from the City Clerk

Greetings! We hope that you and your loved ones are enjoying the 2021 Holiday Season. In this issue, I would like to bring your attention to SafePass L.A., the Comeback Checks Program, and the City's water conservation response.

First, on November 29, 2021, the City launched **SafePass L.A.**, which requires certain establishments to verify that patrons (not employees) are vaccinated against COVID-19. Next, the **Comeback Checks Program** provides \$5,000 grants to approximately 5,000 eligible microenterprises and small businesses in need of economic support in the City of Los Angeles. Finally, we urge BIDs to review the City's **Water Conservation Ordinance** and guidance from the Department of Water and Power.
